

Allowance

Boarding Students Only

Most students receive a weekly allowance while they are in school. If you give your daughter permission to have allowance, the money will come from the Activity Account. There is a separate sheet enclosed which explains the Activity Account. Funds must be available in the account in order for students to receive allowance.

Allowance is the money that you would give your daughter if she were home to buy a soda or split a pizza with friends on a Saturday evening. The allowance is also used to purchase personal hygiene items, laundry detergent, snacks, and other things that she might need or want while at school.

You have complete control of how much allowance your daughter may receive. Most students get \$20 per week. At the bottom of this form is a space for you to complete and return giving your daughter permission to get allowance and letting us know how much per week. If your daughter saves her allowance by skipping a week or more she will be able to get what she has saved. Students pick up their allowance Wednesday afternoon through Friday afternoon from Mrs. Evans at the reception desk in St. Margaret's Hall. If your daughter needs extra money for shopping or a weekend home with a friend, please e-mail or phone Mrs. Evans before 10 a.m. on Wednesday to give permission.
